

Attitudes on NATO integration in Montenegro

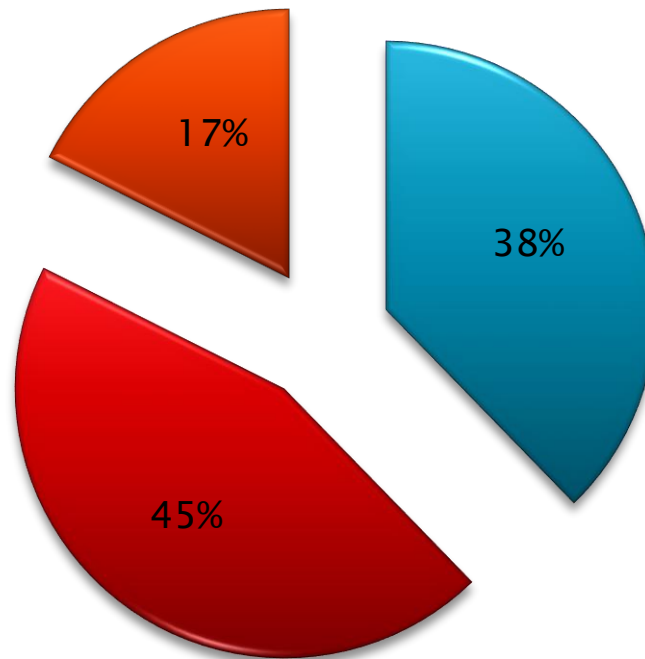

Sample

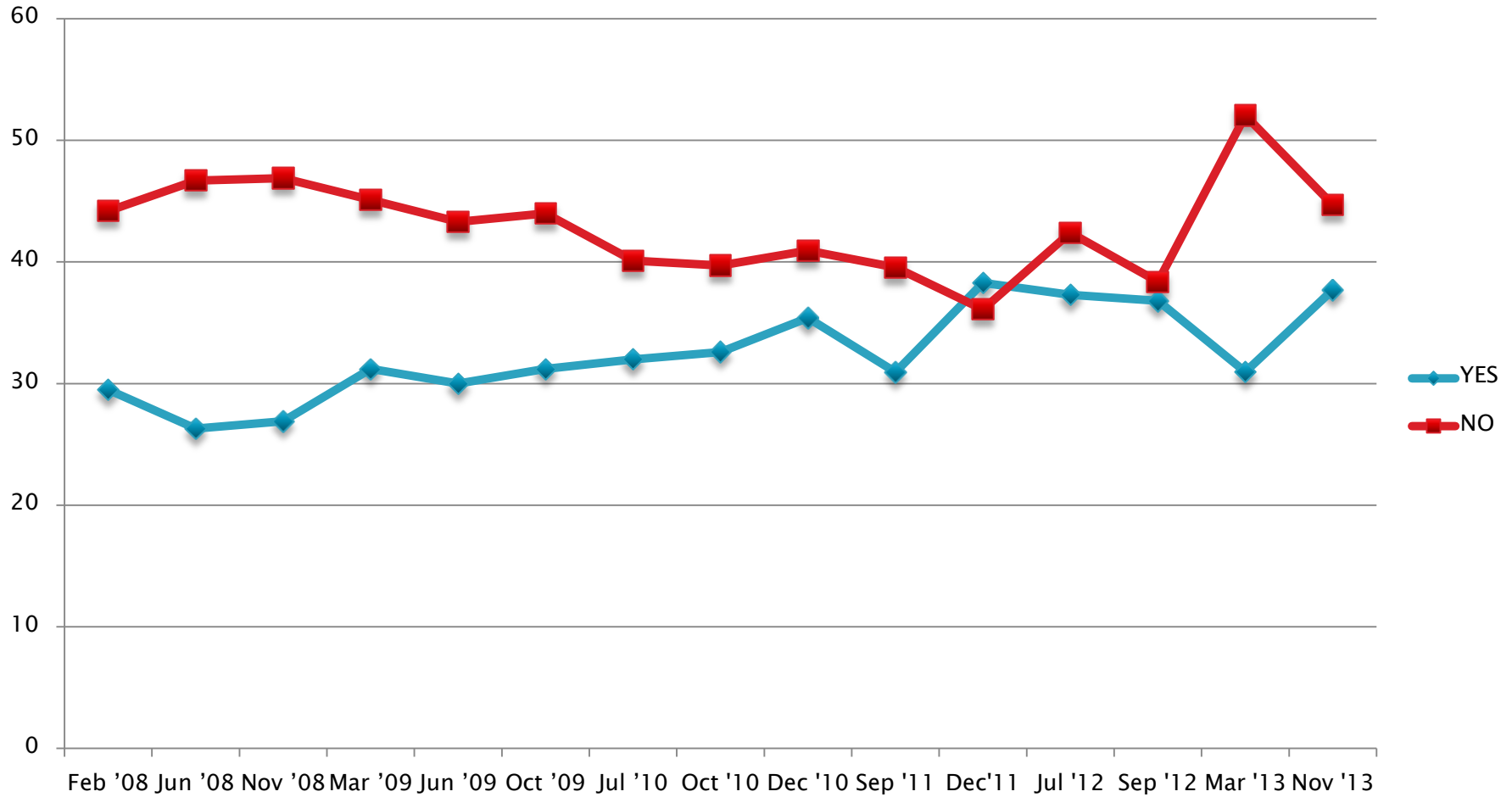
- The sample is representative for adult citizens of Montenegro. The research was conducted in 16 municipalities: Bijelo Polje, Berane, Pljevlja, Podgorica, Nikšić, Cetinje, Herceg Novi, Ulcinj, Bar, Budva, Tivat, Kotor, Rožaje, Plav, Žabljak and Kolašin.
- Total number of respondents - **790**
- Sample: double stratified random selection of respondents within the set enumeration areas
- Standard statistical error: **+/-3,5%** with the incidence of 50% and a confidence interval of 95%
- Post-stratification was done based on gender/sex, age and nationality
- The research was conducted in the period 12 September – 30 November 2013

Support to membership in NATO – % trend YES vs. NO



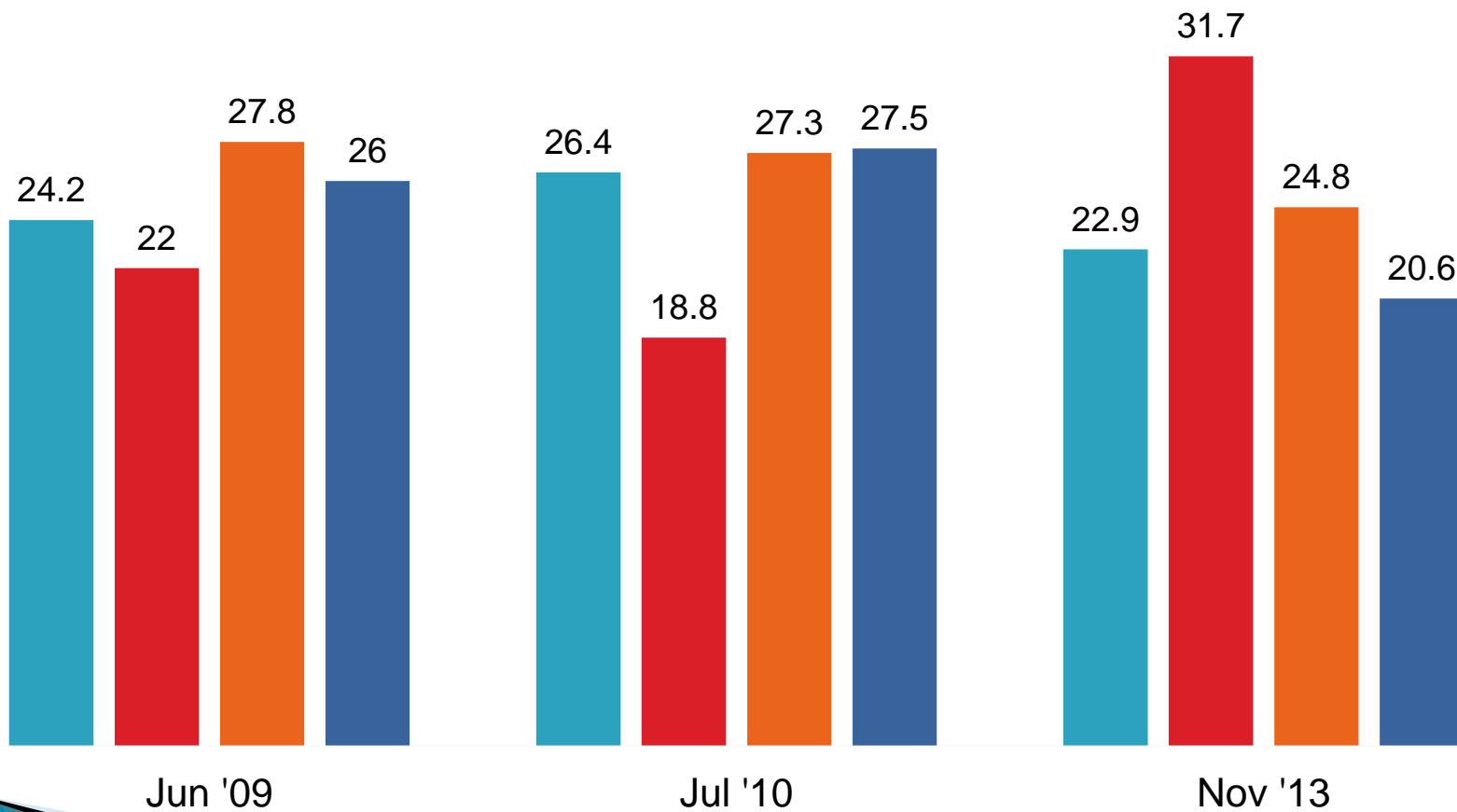
How important is the membership of Montenegro NATO %

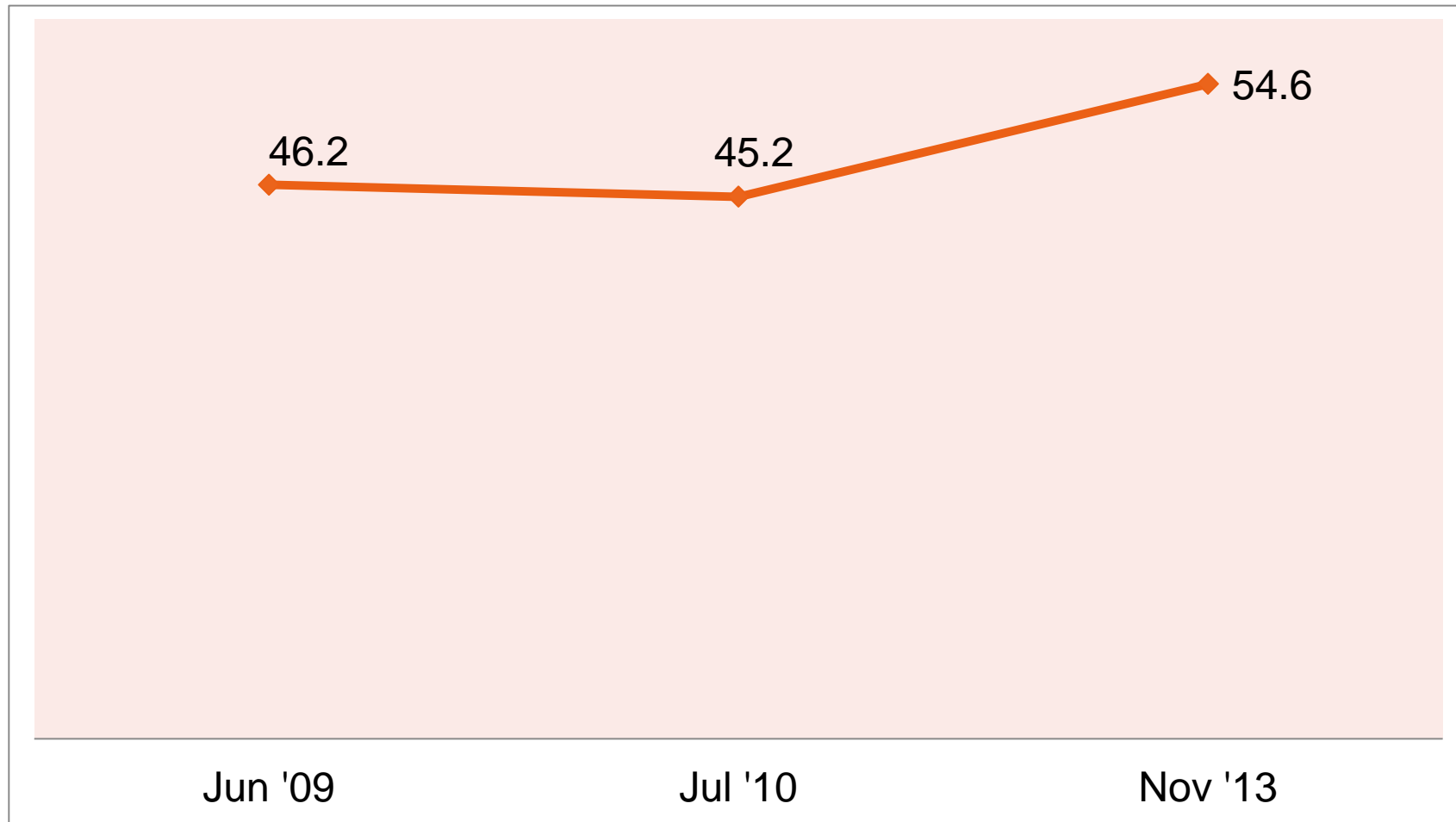

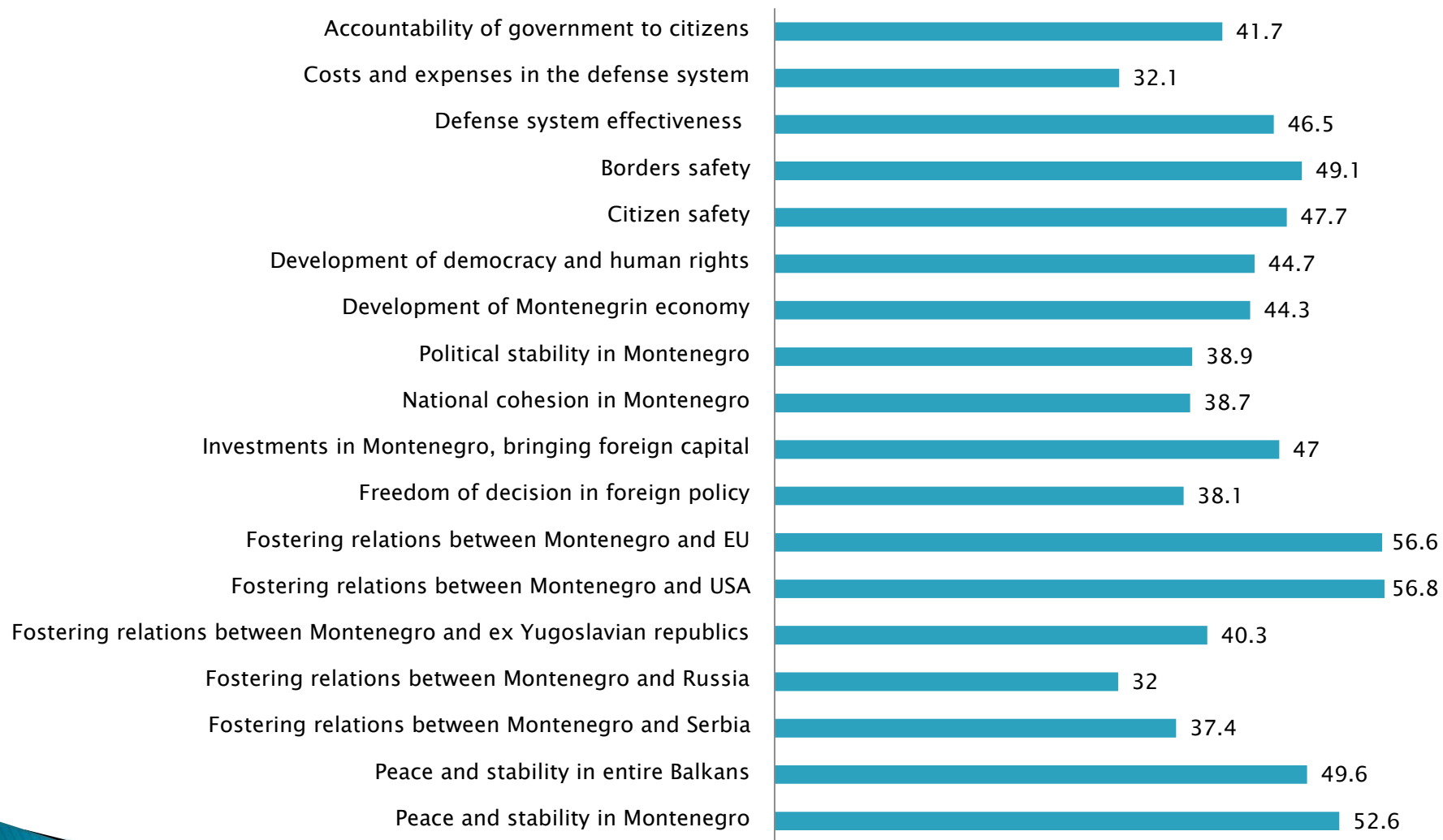

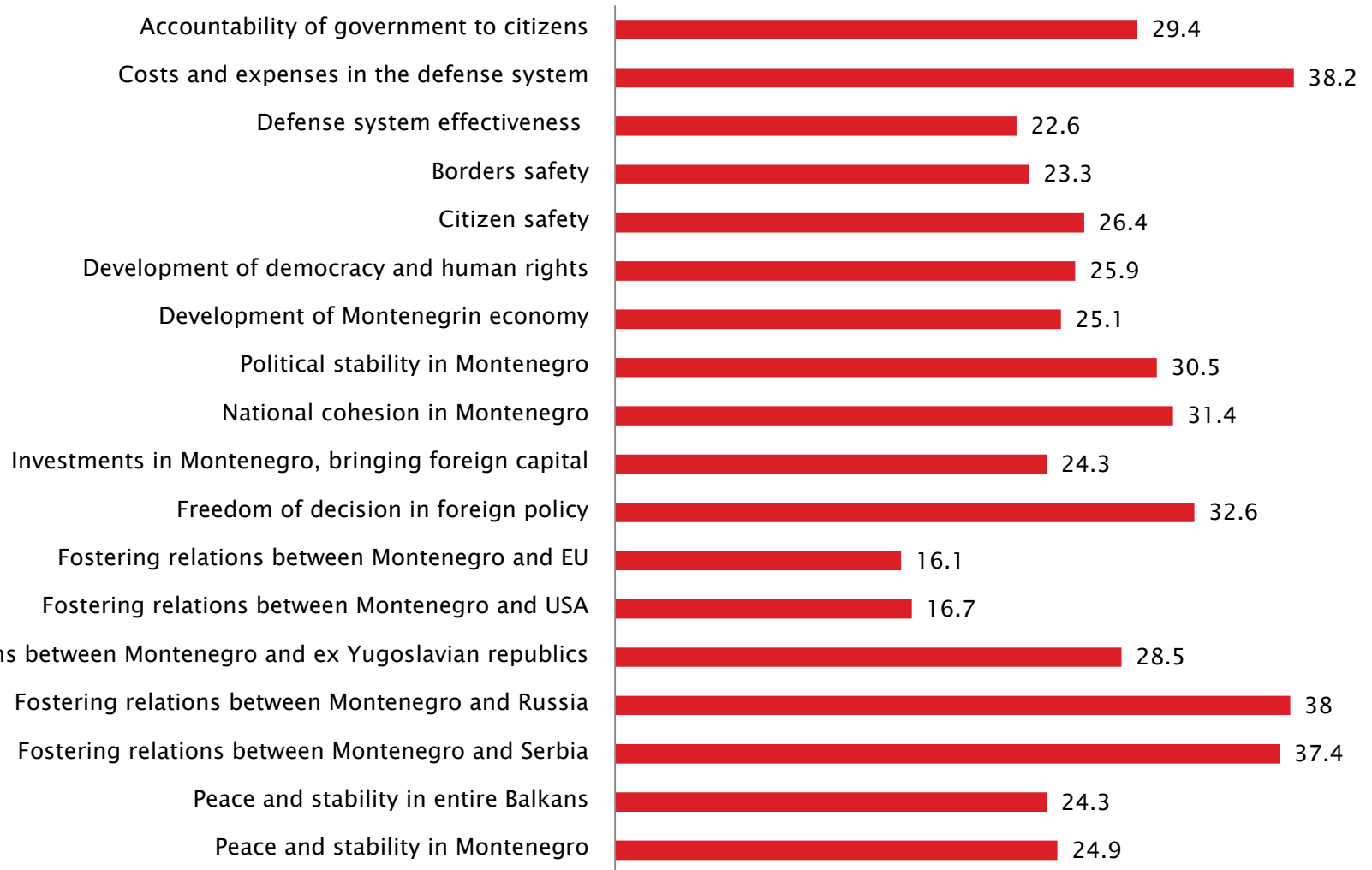
How important is the membership of Montenegro NATO % – SUM



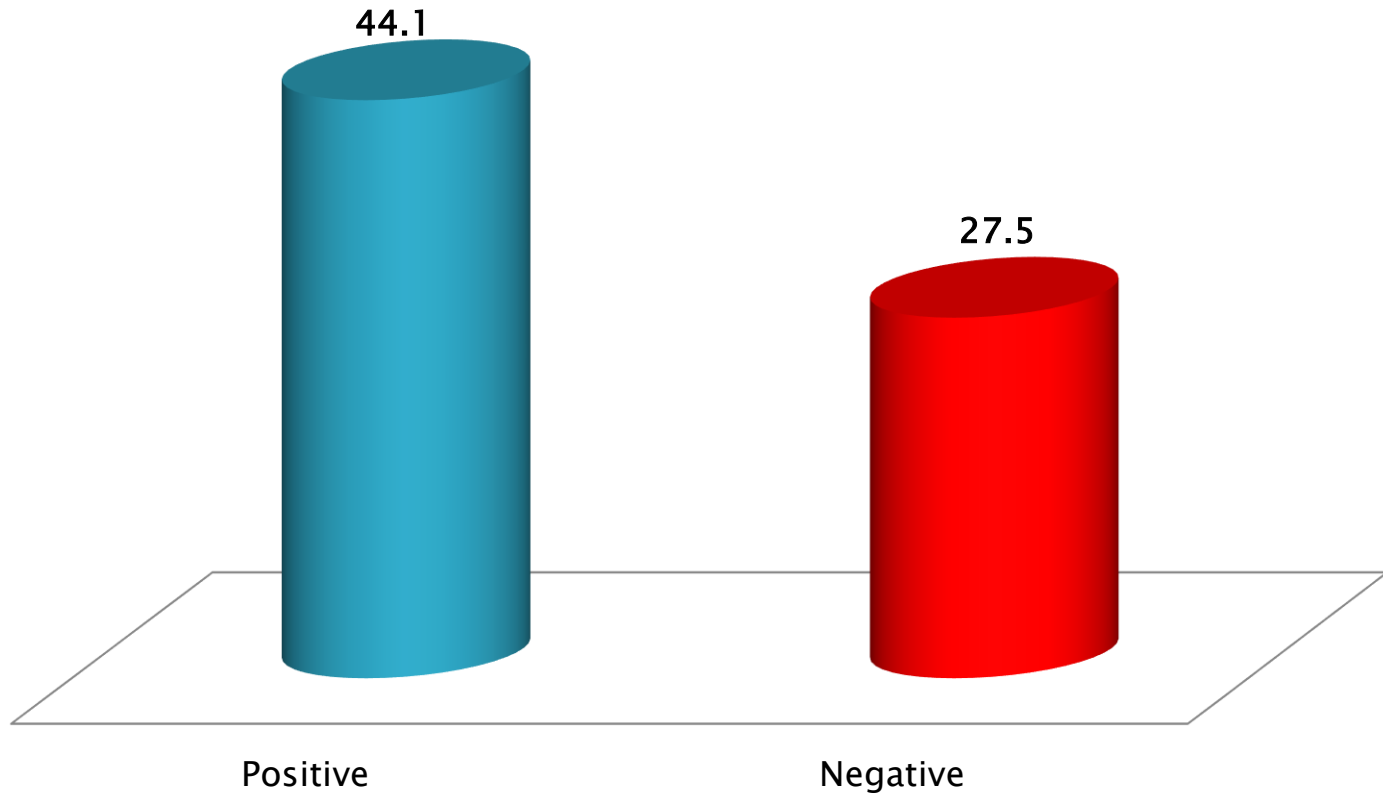
Positive impact of NATO on: SUM %
